## MAINTAINING A RENTAL PROPERTY

You are responsible for basic household maintenance (e.g. replacing light bulbs, cleaning windows, dusting, removing cobwebs etc.) and garden maintenance such as watering, mowing, weeding, pruning and fertilising.

Please keep your rental property clean and in a tidy condition. By completing the following.

- 1. Mow and edge the lawn and verge;
- 2. Weed garden beds and rake up leaves & remove weed growing in between bricks or paving;
- 3. Remove any garden waste from the property;
- 4. Clear cobwebs from any internal and external surfaces;
- 5. Dust window sills and frames. Clean window and sliding door tracks.
- 6. Wipe any finger marks or scuff marks on walls, doors, around light fittings and power points;
- 7. Dust light fittings and replace any missing or broken light bulbs;
- 8. Clean all kitchen surfaces including hotplate and oven. In particular the walls surrounding the stove, griller and drip trays;
- Clean all bathroom and/or laundry surfaces, including toilets and basins. Shower recesses and screens should be scrubbed and grouting to be free of soap residue and mildew;
- 10. Extractor fans and air vents should be removed and cleaned (where applicable);
- 11. All floors and skirting boards to be washed, and carpets to be vacuumed. To prolong the life of the carpet we recommend having them professionally cleaned once a year; and
- 12. Dust and/or clean window treatments.

If you have any maintenance issues you must notify the office as soon as possible.

You must not intentionally or negligently damage property. If you have damaged the property, you must notify the office as soon as possible, within three (3) days of it happening and expect to pay for the repair or replacement of the damaged property.
